- St. John's wort, *Hypericum prolificum*

It Doesn't Need to be Hard

- Chokeberry, *Aronia arbutifolia*
- Showy goldenrod, *Solidago speciosa*
- Red twig dogwood, *Swida (Cornus) sericea*

Don't Assume Anything

- Little bluestem, *Schizachyrium scoparium*
- Switchgrass, *Panicum virgatum*
- Fragrant sumac, *Rhus aromatica*
- Shining sumac, *Rhus copallinum*

Kill Your Lawn

- Pennsylvania sedge, *Carex pensylvanica*
- Wild strawberry, *Fragaria virginiana*

You Can Eat Too!

- Raspberries, *Rubus* spp.
- Blueberries, *Vaccinium* spp.
- Spicebush, *Lindera benzoin*

The Bigger the Better

- Black willow, *Salix nigra*
- Black cherry, *Prunus serotina*
